

Williamstown Borough Authority Meeting Minutes

July 1, 2020

Williamstown Borough Authority met Wednesday July 1, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers. Board Members present were Chairman Stephen Denkovich, Mark Challenger, Jr., Jack Schaeffer, Jr., Lee Moss, and Secretary Lynne Daniel. Sewer Operator, Scott Maurer was also present. Absent was Michael Minnich and Joe Kerwin

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited. The minutes were reviewed and approved as written.

There is no updated information on possible grants. Manager Scott Maurer's report was reviewed. Scott Maurer reported they had called for a 2nd estimate on the piping/filter media but have received no return call to date. Jack Schaeffer, Jr. brought up the discussion on how to move forward with the project. It was decided to start with filters 1 and 2 and pay for it out of the filter media fund already in place. Steve Denkovich made a motion to begin the project, one filter at a time. Mark Challenger, Jr. 2nd the motion and all were in favor. The cost for each filter will be approximately \$7500.00. The road/curbing issue on Ray Street was discussed. Scott Maurer, Joe D'Agostino, Jack Schaeffer, Jr. and Ken Drum were present at the site when Ken stated the collapse/curbing was most likely a result of the water leak. It was decided the curbing will be replaced by the Authority. Estimates were received for only the curbing, Ken Drum will do the digging. Steve Denkovich asked that a written report be obtained from water/sewer personnel on their findings. He also suggested we get another expert opinion for any other issues in question at the area.

The delinquent report was reviewed for a total of \$11,487.07. It was decided penalties and cut-offs for non-payment will resume the end of July. A lien has been placed on the Gonder property and Scott Maurer reported the parts for the muffin monster should be here by the end of July.

Mark Challenger, Jr. made a motion to pay the bills, Lee Moss 2nd and all were in favor. Mark Challenger, Jr. made a motion to adjourn, Jack Schaeffer, Jr. 2nd and all were in favor.
