He is looking in to see what other Authorities would do in a situation like this. Zellers reported that the clean out is on Gonder's property and would affect next customer.

<u>Manager's Report-</u> Reviewed. Biro's hauled sludge. Zellers will also get them to do the pump stations and wet wells, as well as the football field lane. There is about \$18,000 left in budget for hauling. Larry Mugio wants to run sewer to his shed. Drum Excavating will have to run a line at the top of Fairview all the way out to the property line. Muggio would need to pay the \$2,000 tap on fee, as well as paying Drum Excavating. Vice Chair Schaeffer Jr asked how many new meters we have installed, Shane said about 270. Schaeffer Jr informed Zellers to bring surge protector quote to the November meeting.
